Therapy - Vocational Rehabilitation O/P

Programs that enable individuals with disabilities, people who abuse drugs or alcohol, or people who have emotional problems to obtain the training and employment experiences



they need to achieve economic self-sufficiency. Services may include vocational evaluation, work adjustment, work experience, training in marketable skills and placement in competitive employment or a sheltered work environment.

Job Connection

Assists job seekers to locate and maintain gainful employment. Job seekers are screened and efforts are made to match the individual with appropriate employment. Once an individual is hired by an employer, a job coach will work with both the employer and employee to overcome any barriers that might hinder continued employment. Mentoring of basic job skills, assistance accessing transportation and/or child care, and any other assistance deemed appropriate and necessary for the employee to remain employed.
