HOW TO ORGANIZE A DRIVE



FIND A LOCATION

- Chose a high-traffic and easily accessible location.
- Examples: Schools, workplaces, apartment buildings, places of worship, or coffee shops.



SELECT A START AND END DATE

- Donation drives typically run for about one month.
- All donations are due by August 5.
- Build in time for delivery.



SPREAD THE WORD

- Decorate your collection box to catch people's eyes.
- Share on social media, send emails, post flyer, and ask friends and family to participate.



COLLECT DONATIONS

- Continue promoting throughout the drive.
- Use the Collection Sheet to record items received.
- Check and organize items regularly to keep the space tidy.



DELIVER DONATIONS

SAMPLE OUTREACH LETTER

DID YOU KNOW?

- Nearly 1 in 7 NYC students, over 154,000 children, experienced homelessness during the 2024-2025 school year, a record high and the 10th consecutive year above 100,000.
- For NYC students in temporary housing, having a stocked backpack with grade-appropriate supplies is linked to better homework completion, class participation, and academic progress.
- Meeting basic needs like school supplies can reduce stress and support students' social-emotional well-being and academic achievement.
- About 1 in 4 NYC children live below the city's poverty threshold, which was \$47,190 for a family of four renting in 2023.
- In 2024, school supplies cost over \$140 per household on average.
- In one of our supportive housing programs, families are navigating daily life on an average monthly income of \$1,062.
